## Client brief

Originally a Gun Club formed in 1869, The Hurlingham Club was considered 'an agreeable country resort'. These days, it is the internationally renowned exclusive social and athletic club, set in 42 acres of magnificent grounds and is considered to be Britain's greatest private member's club.

Although still quintessentially English in its traditions and heritage, the club provides modern facilities offering sporting, social and dining activities.

Adjacent to the Hurlingham Club itself, the Racquet Centre was added within the Metropolitan Open Land conservation area, to broaden the appeal of the Hurlingham Club's sports and leisure facilities, to the local demographic.

## Our scope

Vision Arch were engaged to carry out the multi-material facade cladding, covering all elevations of the Racquet Centre. Nestled within the insulated vaulted sedum grass roof are 5 rooflights spanning 37m x 3m between each court, adding not only an impressive design feature but also all-important natural light to the courts below.

Married with external vertical glazing, glass louvres and automated vertical Brise Soleil both players and guests can enjoy an enhanced sporting experience.

1. Fulfilling the contract works with as little disruption to the club, which remained open during the works.
2. Our 3-D modelling capabilities were engaged to produce cladding that fitted perfectly around the gentle curves of the roof structure.
